The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

- 1) The Petroleum Distillates and Oil of Citronella should be removed from the active ingredients listing. The total percentage of these ingredients should be included in the total percentage of inert ingredients.
- 2) Change the statement, "Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes.", to read "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater".

A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit five copies of the finished printed label before the product is released for shipment under this revised labeling.

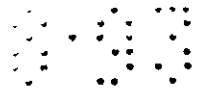
