2. After “*Nominal concentration. See certificate of analysis for actual rotenone content” add “, which is within the certified limits of the nominal concentration.”

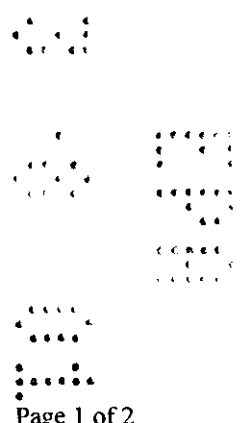
