



#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

THE SOLVENT IN THE ENTIRE SYSTEM MAY BE CHARGED SO GARMENTS CAN BE TREATED AND CLEANED IN ONE ECONOMICAL OPERATION. Check the total amount of solvent in the system, then add 1 pint of Sanex-B to each 25 gallons of solvent. Circulate the charged solvent through the system for a few minutes to obtain a uniform solution. When fresh solvent is added, add 1 pint of Sanex-B to each 25 gallons of new solvent and recirculate.

The active ingredients will be removed by the still. When distillation is constant add 1 pint of Sanex-B to each 25 gallons of distilled solvent that is added to the charged solvent remaining in the system. This can be done after several loads have been run or before beginning the day's operation. Re-circulate the charged solvent in the system when additional Sanex-B is required.
