Dear Ms. Hogue,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

Addition of Listeria monocytogenes

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- 1. Under the "Directions for Use", third sentence, add the term, "*hard*," to the phrase nonporous food contact surfaces.
- 2. The "Statements of Practical Treatment" must be revised to read as follows (You should refer to PR Notice 2001-1):

First Aid

Have product container with you when calling a poison control center, doctor, or going for treatment.

If In Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after 5 minutes. Then continue rinsing the eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

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If On Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Note To Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
