Disinfectant - Deodorant

A PINE OIL DISINFECTANT miscible in water. Used in cleaning water, it will not only disinfect, but will aid in cleaning and cleansing unsoiled places. It is non-corrosive, does not injure cloth, metals, etc., and leaves a sweet, healthy pine odor when used as directed.

FOR DISINFECTING toilet rooms, wash rooms, sinks and in cleaning water for scrubbing floors, washing furniture, woodwork, etc., use 12 tablespoonfuls (6 ounces) to a 10-quart pail of water. Amount can be increased or reduced according to general conditions as a deodorant.

FOR USE IN CHEMICAL TOILET

Remove pail from inside chemical toilet. Pour two gallons of clean (preferably soft) water into pail. Add one-half pint of Pine Oil. Mix thoroughly. Replace pail in toilet. It is now ready for use.

It is always necessary to have enough solution in pail to cover contents completely. Additional quantities may be made by mixing two tablespoonfuls of Pine Oil with one quart of water. Empty pail at least once a week. Waste matter should be disposed of as outlined in the instructions included with your chemical indoor toilet, emptied into the privy or buried.

CAUTION KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

Avoid getting the concentrate in the eyes. In case of contact with the eyes, wash thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Pine-O-Lene is a concentrated product, and should be diluted before using. Do not allow it to come in contact with food. It should not be mixed with soap or other anionic detergents which are incompatible.
