E. DANGER-KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect skin and eyes when handling concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician immediately. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. LIVESTOCK AREA AND EQUIPMENT DISINFECTION

Hy-Kresol, a Veterinary Service, Animal, Plant Health Inspection Service, Permitted Disinfectant for Disinfection and Decontamination of Poultry Houses, Stockyard Premises and Vehicles Used in Interstate Transportation of Livestock.

This disinfectant may be used for official disinfection of stock cars, trucks, boats, aircraft, other vehicles and premises that have contained poultry, livestock, or other animals affected with, or carrying the infection of contagious, infectious or communicable disease of poultry or livestock at a dilution of not less than four fluid ounces of the disinfectant to one gallon of water. Remove poultry or livestock from area. Remove all litter and manure 'from the vehicle or premises. Empty all troughs, feeders and watering equipment. Saturate entire area including walls, floors, chutes, etc. using 4 oz. HY-KRESOL per gallon of water. Do not house poultry or livestock until treatment has absorbed, set or dried. All treated feeders and waterers must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

Not for use in milking stalls, milking parlors, or milk houses.

After treatment of surfaces: Ventilate buildings, vehicles and other closed spaces.
