

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product with its labeling.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats:

Close room and discharge spray mist vigorously in 1 three ounces for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Let ten minutes. Remove bird cages and fish bowls from

To Kill Fleas (infesting premises):

Remove and destroy animal's bedding and spray forcing the spray into all cracks in the floor and

To Kill Grain Weevils, Cadellae, Grain Moths, Flour (accessible stages):

Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface and insect runways at the rate of one gallon of this mix area, equivalent to spraying to point of run-off.

To Kill Roaches and Waterbugs:

Apply in all cracks and crevices in woodwork, and behind pipes, and in all places where roaches and water many insects as possible.

To Kill Clothing Moths, Carpet Beetles:

Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to interior surfaces of storage containers such as closets be regularly sprayed. The treatment should be repeated the articles are stored in a moth-tight container. For beetles, spray both sides of infested rugs, cracks in floors areas where insects tend to congregate and breed.

Areas of Use:

Precautions for Food Areas:
