- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/re-registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 675-57".
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
4. On page 1, 1st paragraph: Shigella dysenteriae was placed wrongly with viruses, and must be placed above with other bacteria.

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5. On page 1, 1st paragraph: the words "microscopically clean" although previously accepted, are considered not exact and potentially misleading to the customer. Replace with the phrase "antimicrobial disinfectants help kill common household germs".


6. On page 1, 2nd and 5th paragraphs: add a statement to clearly indicate product is not for use on food contact surfaces".

7. Under "Directions for use for trigger foamer", move "Big Jobs" between "To disinfect" and "rinse with water". Also, under "Directions for use for non-foamer trigger" move "For floors and big jobs" between "To Disinfect/Deodorize" and "necessary".

You should use "0.001" instead of "0.000" when providing lower certified limits for ingredients which require a wider range of limits than the Agency standards. This was previously requested by the Agency in a letter to S.C. Johnson regarding the parent product. Addresses for suppliers for all inert ingredients should be provided. If necessary, a separate sheet can be attached to the Confidential Statement of formula (CSF) for additional addresses.

Additional label changes are needed for the human-hazard and practical treatment statements. They are acceptable, but changes are needed to conform to the Label Review Manual: the statements, "Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes", should be revised to read "Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling".

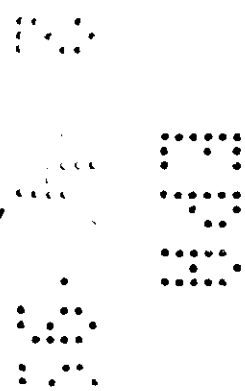

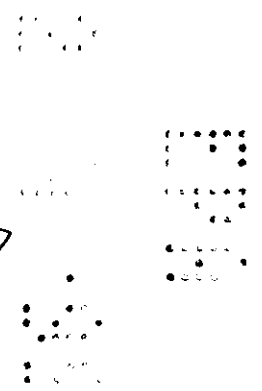

Reapply as new growth appears. *Make sure the product does not contact food. **TO REFILL:** Remove trigger sprayer from empty bottle.
