## DOSAGE AND APPLICATION

FARM BIN APPLICATION: Prepare for fumigation by caulking cracks and filling holes in the bin. Level grain, eliminating peaks and vaile, s in grain surface. For best results bins should not be filled beyond 6 inches of the top.

filled with grain or during turning. Where caking and heating is not a problem, this product may also be applied with a coarse spray on the surface of the grain, giving even wetting over the entire surface area.

FLAT STORAGE: Grain in flat storage is best treated by applying this product evenly over the surface of the grain with power equipment.

ELEVATOR APPLICATION: Make application of DIA-MOND "75-25" when bins are being filled or turned. Pour the fumigant as rapidly as possible directly on the grain stream as it enters the bin. Applications of this fumigant should be regulated to provide the correct dosage for each draft of grain. Add an extra 2 gallons to the last draft and seal bin for at least 7. no. .

SEED FUMIGATION: Most liquid fumigants can affect rhe viability of seed, pasticularly if dosages are excessive, seed moisture is high, temperature high, and exposure period long.


To avoid possibility of less of viability due to fumigation, seed should be fumigated only if the moisture content is less than 12 percent, preferably below 10 percent; exposures should not exceed 24 hours and, preferably, should be 12 hours or less fumigation temperature should not be over 85°F. Fumigant should be removed after treatment period with an aeration fan in tight bins and by removing seals in loosely constructed bins.

CAUTION: Do not re-enter treated bins of tunnels below treated grain. In emergency, re-entry may be made with oxygen-generating respirator or a full-face gas mask with new canister for protect on against organic vapors and gases should be used. In furnigation, the buddy system should be employed with two men as a minimum working together, with one man in fumigation-free area observing the fumigation.
