GENERAL INFORMATION

FENCE RIDER 6T BRUSH KILLER is an emulsifiable formulation which forms an emulsion in water and will mix readily with water free diesel oil fuel oil or kerosene.

FENCE RIDER 6T is designed for use on broadleaf weeds and woody plants in fence rows, hedge rows, rights-of-way, stump lands and certain other waste areas such as vacant lots and around farm buildings where such growth is not wanted. This product is not intended for weed control in growing crops.

DO NOT use or store in or around the home, recreation areas or similar sites.

The following plants are included among those susceptible to FENCE RIDER 6T:

NOTE: Regulations governing airplane applications of herbicides are in effect in many states. Consult local regulatory agencies covering requirements.

TREATING SMALL AREAS: One tablespoonful of FENCE RIDER 6T in 1-1/2 gallons of water or oil is about equal to 1 quart in 100 gallons.

When stored at temperatures below freezing it may be necessary to warm up to at least 45° F. and shake thoroughly before using.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE



PREPARATION OF THE SPRAY: Fill the spray tank with half the required amount of water or water-free diesel oil, fuel oil or kerosene, add the recommended amount of FENCE RIDER 6T with agitation and continue filling the spray tank with water or petroleum oil.

In straight oil mixtures do not let water get into the FENCE RIDER 6T itself or into the finished product.

FOLIAGE TREATMENT: Foliage or leaf stem sprays are used during the growing season on dense brush or where vine growth such as Smilax, greenbrier and other woody vines is a problem. Apply FENCE RIDER 6T after foliage is well developed using a drenching spray containing 2 to 2-2/3 quarts in 100 gallons of water. Coverage should be complete, wetting all parts of the plants, including leaves and stems, to point of run-off. Applications are more effective when applied to actively growing plants. Higher volumes are necessary where the brush is very dense and over 8 to 10 feet high. DO NOT treat during periods of severe drought or in early fall when leaves have lost their healthy green color. Hard-to-kill species may need retreatment the following season.

BASAL BARK TREATMENT: This treatment is not adapted for spraying dense stands of brush and woody vines. It can be used anytime of the year to obtain better kill of some species where dense brush and woody vines do not prevent proper application. Apply FENCE RIDER 6T at the rate of 2-1/5 quarts in 25 gallons (3/4 pint in 3 gallons) of fuel oil, diesel oil or kerosene, treating the basal parts of stems or tree trunks less than 6 inches in diameter from ground line to a height of 12 to 16 inches, thoroughly wetting to run-off all sides of the indicated area. response to treatment can be expected. Treated brush or trees preferably should not be cut for one year following treatment.

STUMP TREATMENT: To prevent regrowth from cut stems and stubs, apply a solution of 2-1/5 quarts of FENCE RIDER 6T in 25 gallons of water-free diesel oil or kerosene (3/4 pint in 3 gallons). Wet thoroughly the cut surfaces of the stump, concentrating the spray on the outside edges, sides of the stump and exposed roots until run-off to ground line is noticed. Best results are usually obtained when applied to freshly-cut stumps two inches in diameter or larger.

MESQUITE CONTROL: For airplane application to original or undisturbed growth with dense foliage, use 1/2 pint of FENCE RIDER 6T in 1/2 gallon diesel oil and water to make an application of 3 gallons of spray solution per acre. For sprouts or regrowth at least 4 feet tall or more and 4-6 years old with dense foliage, apply 2/3 pint in 1 gallon of diesel oil and water to make an application of 4 gallons of solution per acre. DO NOT treat if drought prevents full foliage.

Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. If contact with eyes occurs, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes.

DO NOT store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes.

Use care to avoid spray drift to 2,4,5-T susceptible plants such as cotton, tomatoes, flowers, grapes, fruit trees and ornamentals. Trace amounts of spray drift may cause severe injury to both growing and dormant plants. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Spray only on calm days using low pressure and lowered boom. VAPORS from this product may injure 2,4,5-T sensitive plants in the vicinity.

Flush sprayer out on suitable non-crop area after use. DO NOT use the same spray equipment for applying other material: to plants as injury will result.

DO NOT graze dairy animals on treated areas within 6 weeks after application. DO NOT graze near animals on treated areas within 2 weeks of slaughter.

DO NOT reuse empty container. Return to drum reconditioner, or destroy by perforating, crushing and burying or discarding in a safe place.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. DO NOT contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply only as directed in this label.
