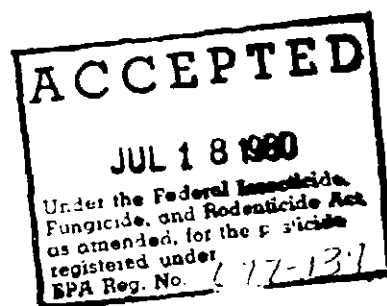
Environmental Hazards

Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for irrigation or domestic purposes. Use care to avoid drift to 2,4-D susceptible plants such as cotton, tomatoes, flowers, grapes, fruit trees and ornamentals. Trace amounts may cause severe injury to both growing and dormant plants. Apply only on calm days to prevent drift. Although this ester is much less volatile than butyl or isopropyl esters, high temperatures may produce vapors after application which may injure 2,4-D sensitive plants in the vicinity. Clean applicator out thoroughly after use. Do not use same equipment for applying other materials to plants as injury will result.

General Information

Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular is formulated as a free-flowing 4-D Granule using a low volatility ester of 2,4-D as the active ingredient.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Although **Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular** is specifically formulated for weed control in ponds and lakes, it may be used for the control of broadleaved weeds such as dandelion, plantain and certain other broadleaved weeds infesting grasses on golf courses, playgrounds and other recreation areas.

Lawns: When broad leaved weeds appear on lawns and similar turf areas, apply **Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular** at the rate of 1 pound per 4,000 square feet (40 x 100 ft) using a conventional sprayer adjusted to a low setting. For uniform coverage several passes may be necessary to empty the hopper over the treated area. Adjustments can be used to accurately calibrate the spreader to deliver the required amount of **Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular**. Avoid application to creeping grasses such as bent grass or new grass seedling areas until grasses have become well established. **Do not** apply closer than three feet to ornamental plantings such as shrubs or flowers. This product may cause injury to Dichondra and ivy.

Aquatic Weeds (Ponds and Lakes): To control summer perennial water weeds such as waterhyacinth, ditch moss, milfoil, fanwort, tape grass, naiad, ludwigia and certain other pond weeds, apply **Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular** at the rate of 1 pound per 430 square feet of water surface. Avoid application to choppy water as the granules must settle on the bottom and roots and stems in a uniform manner. Results should be visible in about 4 to 6 weeks. After application, control can be obtained for approximately 1 to 4 years. **Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular** may be applied in the winter on the ice surface before spring thaw at the rate of 100 pounds per acre. Consult your State Fish & Game Department before applying this product.

Caution: Decaying vegetation in treated areas of the pond or lake may deplete the oxygen supply in the water. This will result in suffocation of the fish. To avoid this, apply **Crop Rider 20% Aqua Granular** in wide bands or sections of the lake or pond. The treated portion should not exceed more than one half of the area of the lake or pond at any time except in the case of winter application. Repeat treatment to the untreated area after vegetation has thoroughly decomposed. This should be approximately 2 or 3 months after treatment.

Storage and Disposal

Storage—Do not store in contact with water. Store in a cool, dry place. **Do not** store near food, feed, drugs, or other products used by humans or animals.

Disposal—Do not reuse empty container. Pesticide that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place.

Open dumping is prohibited.

Do not burn.

Consult federal, state or local government for approved alternative procedures.
