
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply LO-VOL 6D, 11 oz. to 22 oz. per acre, with air or ground equipment after the hard dough (dent stage) to suppress weeds that interfere with harvest such as bindweed, cocklebur, dogbane, jimsonweed, ragweed, sunflower, velvetleaf and certain other broadleaf weeds, and to decrease production of weed seeds. The high rate should be used on difficult-to-control weeds growing under stress conditions.

NOTE: This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
