General Classification

Place female tag under clip by depressing lever. Collar on tag must be pointing down.



Figure 2.

Slide male button on pin until it projects through tip. Tag and button are now ready for application. Disinfect pliers and tags prior to application.



Position tag on the flat surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the male button to penetrate any cartilage rib or blood vessel. Ear damage may result.



When properly positioned the tag should hang as shown.

Use Directions: Attach tags when pests first appear in early spring. For hornflies one tag per animal will give season long (5-6 months) control. One tag in each ear will give effective control of Gulf Coast and spinose ear ticks, face flies, horn flies, and aids in control of stable flies and houseflies. Replace as necessary. Apply with the Allflex Tagging System.
