

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans

Caution

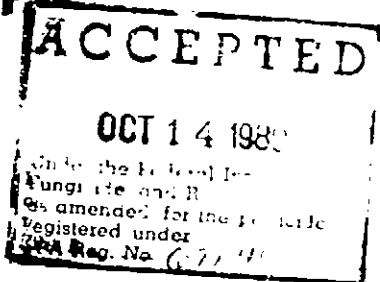
