

### Statement of Practical Treatment

**If swallowed:** Give milk or water and induce vomiting by administration of syrup of ipecac or by touching finger to back of throat. Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

**If in eyes:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**If on skin:** Wash off with soap and water.

### Precautionary Statements — Hazards to Humans

**Caution:** Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Wear rubber gloves when applying. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

### Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To treat pets for ticks and fleas, add the contents of one sachet to 1 gallon of water and mix thoroughly. Sponge the solution on pet until skin is wet. Apply in the ears and between the toes to insure complete tick control. Allow solution to dry on the pet for maximum residual effect. Repeat treatment as necessary but not more often than weekly. Do not store for reuse any remaining portion of the mixed solution.

### Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal of this product. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
