




COLLOIDAL LINDANE 40%



CAUTION: Animals should have access to shade following dipping or spraying in warm weather. Do not spray or dip when weather is excessively cold or hot. Do not treat animals under 3 months of age. Avoid treating overheated or sick animals.

Lindane Colloidal may cause off-flavor and odor to certain edible crops.
DO NOT APPLY to any crop not listed on the label.
DO NOT APPLY to crops in rotation with root crops.
DO NOT APPLY to cucurbits (Cantaloupes, cucumber, squash, melon) as injury to the plants may result.
 Observe use limitations given on the label for specific crops.

Do not apply during bloom when honey bees or other pollinators are active. Avoid drifts to adjoining food and forage crops.
 Do not apply on food or forage crops to be fed to dairy animals or to animals being finished for slaughter.

SUGGESTIONS — AGRICULTURAL USE

APPLES: Aphids. Use ½ pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not apply later than 10 days before harvest. **DO NOT APPLY MORE THAN ONE ACRE PER APPLICATION. DO NOT USE WITHIN 60 DAYS OF HARVEST.**

CHERRIES: Aphids. Use ¼ pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not use later than 10 days before harvest.

GRAPES: Use one quart per acre in sufficient water for growth. Do not use later than 10 days before harvest.

PEARS: Aphids. ½ pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not use later than 10 days before harvest.

PRUNES and PLUMS: Aphids. ½ pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not use later than 10 days before harvest.


ROSES, ORNAMENTALS, GREENHOUSE ORNAMENTALS: Use 4 ounces per 100 gallons of water for control of Aphids, Thrips, Lacebugs, Leaf Miners, Leaf Rollers, Psylla, Armyworms, etc. Repeat applications as necessary or as indicated on label. **CAUTION:** This material is highly toxic to plants and infestation. Use should be made cautiously until matter of phyto-toxicity is determined.

DEER CATTLE: For control of ticks, hornflies, screwworms, etc. Use 7½ ozs. per 100 gallons for dip or spray. **DO NOT DIP ANIMALS WITHIN 30 DAYS OF SLAUGHTER. DO NOT USE WITHIN 15 MONTHS OF AGE. KEEP AT LEAST 15 DAYS BETWEEN APPLICATIONS.**



BARNYARDS: For fly control, use 1 quart per 100 gallons of water. Do not use on surfaces. Do not contain water.

SUGGESTIONS — AGRICULTURAL USES

APPLES: Aphids. Use 1/2 pint per 100 gallons of water. May be used as late as post fall for control of rosy aphid. **DO NOT APPLY MORE THAN 5 PINTS PER ACRE PER APPLICATION. DO NOT USE WITHIN 60 DAYS OF HARVEST.**

CHEERRIES: Aphids. Use 1/4 pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not apply to foliage or fruit, after fruit starts to form.

GRAPES: Use one quart per acre in sufficient water for good coverage for control of grape phylloxera (leaf form only). Do not use later than one month after bloom.

PEARS: Aphids. 1/2 pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not use within 60 days of harvest.

PRUNES and PLUMS: Aphids. 1/2 pint per 100 gallons of water. Do not use within 60 days of harvest.

ROSES, ORNAMENTALS, GREENHOUSE ORNAMENTALS, NURSERY PLANTS: Use 4 ounces per 100 gallons of water for control of Aphids, Thrips, Flea Beetle Larvae, Lacebugs, Leaf Miners, Leaf Rollers, Psylla, Armyworms, Grasshoppers, and Tarnish Bugs. Repeat applications as necessary or as indicated, depending upon size, density of plants and infestation. **CAUTION:** This material is toxic to many plants. Use should be made cautiously until matter of phyto-toxicity is determined.

BEEF CATTLE: For control of ticks, hornflies, screwworms, Spines ear ticks. Use 7 1/2 ozs. per 100 gallons for dip or spray. **DO NOT DIP ANIMALS WITHIN 60 DAYS, OR SPRAY WITHIN 30 DAYS OF SLAUGHTER. DO NOT TREAT CALVES UNDER 3 MONTHS OF AGE. KEEP AT LEAST 15 DAYS BETWEEN APPLICATIONS.**

DO NOT USE ON DAIRY CATTLE.

BARN: For fly control, use 1 quart per 100 gallons of water spray for coverage but not to run off, for surface application. Do not contaminate feed or drinking water.

DO NOT USE IN POULTRY HOUSES, DAIRY BARN OR MILK ROOMS.
