



# Royal Kay Oil

**RECOMMENDATIONS:** For Apples, Pears and Stone Fruits – Dormant and delayed Dormant (before buds open) – for control of Pear Psylla, mites, aphids and scales, use 2½ gallons of Royal Kay Oil to each 100 gallons of spray when using 300 to 600 gallons per acre. Gallonage per acre should be sufficient to wet trees completely and thoroughly to contact eggs and insects protected by bark.

**PEARS:**

Summer Spray – 1 to 1½ gallons of Royal Kay Oil per 100 gallons of water for control of Pear Psylla, mites and aphids and and to prevent excessive transpiration.

**APPLES:**

Summer Spray – ½ to 1 gallon per 100 gallons of water for aphids and mites. Kay Oil has ovicidal action against common insect eggs exposed to contact with oil.
