DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This dust should be applied when air is calm. To obtain most effective results, a good hand or power dusting machine should be used to provide complete coverage of plants with a uniform deposit of dust. Begin applications at the first sign of infestation and repeat as needed to maintain control, but observe use limitations given for specific crops.

OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING USE PRECAUTIONS

Observe use limitations given on the label for specific crops. DO NOT apply during bloom when honey bees or other pollinators are active. Avoid dust drift to adjoining food and forage crops about to be harvested, or crops in bloom. Apply in early morning or evening when there is little or no wind. The Federal Food and Drug Administration has set official tolerances for certain pesticide residues. In order that residues on food and forage crops will not exceed established tolerances, use only at recommended rates and do not apply closer to harvest than specified. Before marketing food crops, remove residues by washing, stripping, wiping or other effective means. Consult local agricultural extension service authorities for timing of applications and further specific information.

RECOMMENDATIONS

ALFALFA — For control of aphids, including yellow clover aphid, potato leafhopper, spider mites, spittlebugs, vetch bruchid and alfalfa weevil larvae, apply at the rate of 30 lbs. per acre. Repeat applications as necessary.

NOTE. DO NOT APPLY TO ALFALFA IN BLOOM. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest or pasturing.

APPLES: For control of aphids, spider mites, tarnish bug, leaf hopper — use 60 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest. May injure foliage on some varieties.

APRICOTS: For control of Twig Borer, lygus bugs — use 60 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

BEANS — Mexican bean beetle, leafhoppers, black bean aphids — Apply 30 lbs. per acre. Make two or more applications as needed. Last application 1 day before harvest.

BEETS — Aphids, mites, tarnish bugs, loopers — Use 20-30 lbs. per acre (do not exceed). Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

CHERRIES — For control of Cherry Fruit Fly, Aphids — Use 60 lbs. per acre. Use caution, may injure foliage of some varieties. Last application 3 days before harvest.

CORN — For control of Aphids, spider mites, corn-earworm, army worm — Use 20-30 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest or forage use.

GRAPES — Grape leafhopper and spider mites, mealy bug — use 20-40 lbs. per acre. Make one or more applications as needed. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest. May injure foliage of some varieties.

HOPS — Aphids, spider mites, loopers — use 20 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

MINT — Spider mites, loopers, aphids — use 20 lbs. per acre (do not exceed). Repeat applications as needed. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

NACHES — Aphids, twig-borer — Use 60 lbs. per acre. Last application no later than 7 days before harvest.

PEARS — mites, aphids, psylla — 20 lbs. per acre. Do not apply later than 7 days before harvest.

PRUNES — Prune house, spider mites, brown mite — use 30 lbs. per acre. Last application three days before harvest.

PEAS — Pea Aphid — Apply 25 lbs. per acre. Make 2-3 applications within 7 days of harvest.

Destroy bags by burning. Keep out of smoke and fumes.
