DANGER—POISON—PRECAUTIONS

CAN KILL YOU IF SWALLOWED

This product can bift you if swallowed even in small amounts, spray mist or dust may be fatal if sea'loaed

CAN KILL YOU BY SKIN CONTACT

This product can kill you if touched by hands or spilled or splashed on skin, in eyes or on clothing (liquid goes through clothes)

CAN KILL YOU IF BREATHED

This product can kill you if vapors, spray mist or dust

POISONOUS TO FISH AND WILDLIFE

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

USE OFLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING

(1) Wear mater proof pants, coat, hat, rubber boots or rutter overshoes (2) Wear safety gozgles (3) Wear mask or respirator approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for parathion protection (4) Wear heavy duty, natural rubber gloves

WORK SAFETY NULES

Keep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift.

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician) clinic or hospital—immediately Explain that the nichm has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given (see Eirst Aid Treatment Section) and if a docfor cannot come, take victim to clinic or hospital

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water Always wash hands, face and arms with scap and water before smoking, eating or drinking

AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes Chower, using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with scap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and filter replaced according to instructions included with respirator

POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly en ters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are Headache nausea, vomiting cramps weakness blurred vision pin point pupils, tightness in chest labored breathing, nervousness, smeating, watering of eyes drooking or frothing of mouth and nose muscle spasms and coma

+ FIRST AND TREATMENT +

Calca doctor (physic an), clinic or hospital immedi ately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim. If suclimed and victim is anake (conscious) make him vomit quickly. Induce comiting by sticking finger to drink. Receat until vomit is clear. Never give and thing by mouth to an unconscious person. Have sict in Le down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doc tor immediately

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Antidate —administer atropine sulfate in large doses TAO to FOUR mg. intravencusty or intramuscularly as iscon as cyanosis is overcome. Pepeat at 5 to 10 min. ute intervals until signs of atropicization appear 2 PAW chloride is also antidotal and may be admin istered in conjunction with atropine DO NOT GIVE MOPPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS Parathon is a strong cholinesterase in bitor affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing car diac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be given supple mental caygen and treated symptomatically. Con thiles assorption of the poison may occur and fatal relayies have here less than after in tall improve ment VERY GLUSE SUPERVISION UP THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS
