USE PRECAUTIONS

Observe suggested rates and do not exceed the recommended dosages. Do not apply closer to harvest than is specified. When two different dosage rates are given, be sure to check time of last application. For further information consult your local Agricultural Extension Service Authorities.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

DO NOT COMBINE COLLOIDAL SUSPENSIONS, WETTABLE POWDER OR EMULSIFIABLE CONCENTRATES unless previous experience assures compatibility.

ALFALFA: For control of Alfalfa Caterpillars, Alfalfa Weevil (larvae), Armyworm, Corn earworm, Flea-beetles, Leaf-hoppers, Lygus-bugs, Spittle-bugs. Use from 6 to 9 pints per acre. Use sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage. Last application no closer than 7 days before harvest.

APPLES: For control of Climbing cutworms, Lygus bugs. Use four (4) gallons per acre in full coverage spray. Repeat application if necessary. Last application no less than 7 days before harvest.

ASPARAGUS: For control of Asparagus beetle, Flea-beetle, and Climbing cutworm, use 7 pints per acre in sufficient water for thorough coverage. Last application at this rate no closer than 7 days before harvest. Minimum suggested rate is 50 gallons of water per acre. If infestation, age of planting warrants a lower rate, use 4½ pints per acre. Last application no closer to harvest than three (3) days, unless crop is washed and/or blanched.

BEANS: For control of Bean leaf beetle, Cutworms, Corn earworm, Leaf Hoppers, Mexican bean beetle. Use 5 quarts per acre. Last application no closer to harvest than 3 days.

CORN: For control of Corn earworm, Army worm, use 4½ pints per acre in sufficient water for thorough coverage. Last application no closer than 7 days before harvest. Soil application for control of cutworms, use 10 quarts per acre, in sufficient water for thorough coverage. Work the material into the soil completely and thoroughly for best results.

PEAS & BLACK-EYED PEAS - For control of cucumber beetle, Pea weevils, Alfalfa hoppers, Corn earworm, Army worm, use 5 quarts per acre, in at least 50 gallons of water minimum, per acre. Last application no closer than 7 days before harvest.

BEETS: For control of Lygus bugs, Leaf Hoppers, Climbing cutworms, Army worms, Blister beetle, Cucumber beetle, use 5 quarts of Methoxychlor in a minimum of 50 gallons of water in ground equipment. If foliage density and insect infestation are acute, increase amount of water for better distribution. Last application, 7 days before harvest if tops are to be used as food or forage.

TOMATOES: Blister beetle, Cucumber beetle, Climbing cutworms, Army worms, Corn earworm, use 6 pints per acre in a minimum of 50 gallons of water. Last application 7 days prior to harvest.
