## CAUTION

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Classification — Available to the public.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Container should be disposed of by crushing and burying with wastes.

For airplane application use a minimum of 10 gallons of water and where possible use 20 gallons per acre.

**ALFALFA:** For control of Alfalfa caterpillars, Alfalfa weevils (larvae), Fall armyworms, Leafhoppers and Spittle-bugs — use from 6 to 9 pts/acre. Use sufficient water to obtain thorough coverage. Last application no closer than 7 days before harvest.

**ASPARAGUS:** For control of Asparagus beetles and Flea-beetles — use 5 qts. per acre in sufficient water for thorough coverage. Last application at this rate no closer than 7 days before harvest. Minimum suggested rate is 50 gallons of water per acre. If infestation, age of planting warrants a lower rate, use 3 qts. per acre. Last application no closer to harvest than 3 days, unless crop is washed and/or blanched.

**BEANS:** For control of Bean leaf beetles, Corn earworms, Potato leafhoppers, and Mexican bean beetles — use 7 qts. per acre. Last application no closer to harvest than 3 days.

**BEETS:** For control of Leaf hoppers, Fall armyworms and Blister beetles — use 7 qts. per acre in a minimum of 50 gallons of water in ground equipment. If foliage density and insect infestation are acute, increase amount of water for better distribution. Last application 14 days before harvest if tops are to be used as feed or forage.

**CORN:** For control of Fall armyworms — use 9 qts. per acre in sufficient water for thorough coverage. Last application no closer than 7 days before harvest.

**ORNAMENTALS:** Such as Lilac, Roses, Beauty Bush, Trumpet vines; shade trees such as Maple, Birch, Willows; and border plants such as Tulips, Hyacinths, Zinnia, Marigold — for control of Leaf hoppers, and Japanese beetles — use 1 to 2 qts. per 100 gallons of water depending on the degree of infestation.

**PEAS and BLACK-EYED PEAS:** For control of Cucumber beetles, Pea weevils, and Corn earworms — use 7 qts. per acre, in at least 50 gallons of water minimum, per acre. Last application no closer than 7 days before harvest.

**TOMATOES:** For control of Blister beetles and Fall armyworms — use 9 qts. per acre in a minimum of 50 gallons of water. Last application 7 days prior to harvest.
