8-16 gals. per acre in a minimum of 400 gallons of water. Apply prior
to swell bud stage.

CHERRIES: For Coryneum Blight and bacterial gummosis suppression
— use 10-16 gals. per acre in a minimum of 400 gallons of water. Apply
prior to swell bud stage.

PEACHES: For Coryneum Blight suppression — use 10-16 gals. per acre
in a minimum of 400 gallons of water. Apply prior to swell bud stage.

BARTLETT PEARS: For Fire Blight suppression — use 2 qts. per 100
gallons of water starting at full bloom and repeating at weekly intervals
until all bloom is gone. Do not spray D'Anjou as it may cause fruit
russetting. Do not use until pollination has occurred. Copper may
suppress pollination.
