DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Cover thoroughly the tops of the vegetation and the surface of the ground.

Do not apply during or immediately following rain.

DO NOT apply to areas overlaid with roots of desirable vegetation, or where rain may leach this product to such root zones.

"DO NOT reuse container. Destroy when empty."

"DO NOT store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To control annual Broadleaf weeds and grasses. Apply 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. per 100 sq. ft.

To control most perennial broadleaf weeds and grasses: Apply 1 - 2 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. Where deep-rooted perennials are present use the 2 lb. rate.

CAUTION: Keep persons and animals OFF treated areas. Harmful if swallowed. Strong oxidant. This material will cause slight skin irritation on prolonged contact. In case of skin contact, wash at once with water.
