STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place. Do not store in plastic containers. Do not use if the container is damaged or leaking.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides. Do not dispose in a safe place away from water supply. Do not use for empty containers and for metal containers after reconditioning or reconditioning. For plastic containers, dispose in an incinerator or disposal site of approved pesticide containers. Do not dispose in a safe place. Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CDS is an effective anti-bacterial cleaner designed for use in industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, CDS will disinfect hard non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, diaper pails, food storage areas, animal quarters and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose anti-bacterial detergent in schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms and other places where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CLEANING

LIGHTLY SOILED AREA: Surfaces to be cleaned should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 1 ounce of CDS per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned area with fresh water.

HEAVILY SOILED AREA: Mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 2.5 ounces of CDS per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard non-porous surfaces in restrooms, locker rooms and other public areas, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of CDS per gallon of water. To maintain disinfection, mop or brush surfaces with fresh solution. Surfaces must be pre-cleaned with a detergent solution before disinfection. These surfaces will not be effective if contaminated with food or grease. Do not use on fabrics. Do not reuse solution.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard non-porous surfaces in hospitals and nursing homes, mop or brush with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of CDS per gallon of water. To maintain thoroughly wetted surface for ten minutes. All soiled surfaces must be cleaned prior to disinfection in the following directions for cleaning: Those surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal material or exudates should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 7 ounces of CDS per gallon of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces of CDS per gallon of water before disinfection. Do not reuse used solution. This product has not been tested for effectiveness against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* and must not be relied upon when tuberculosis activity is intended by the user.

DEODORIZATION

Prior to deodorization of bathroom areas, garbage pits, diaper pits, food storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where objectionable odors may develop, remove all garbage, refuse, food and/or animals. Pre-clean surfaces using pressurized water, where possible, before deodorization. To deodorize, mop or brush surfaces thoroughly with a solution containing 2 ounces of CDS per gallon of water.
