NEW IMPROVED WARFARIN RODENTICIDE

DIRECTIONS:

Place tablespoonful amounts ($\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ ounces) of bait should be placed at 8-12 foot intervals and place where mice have been seen or heard. Allow bait to remain in places until complete lack of feeding is noted.

When placed in locations where reinfestation may occur, will not only control the mice present, but will be available to destroy other mice as they invade the premises. For best results, be sure that is available at all times. Keep bait dry and use no decomposed, mouldy or sour bait.

At the concentration of 0.025% Warfarin, the danger to household pets is minimum, but baits should be protected from children, dogs, cats and livestock by means of bait boxes or cages where necessary.

NOTICE: Baiting should continue until complete lack of feeding is noted. This should be from five to fourteen days.

Caution: contains as its active ingredient an anti-coagulant chemical which if taken by humans, domestic animals, or pets may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and hemorrhage may result. In case baits are eaten give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIAN: When a human has been known to have ingested blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdose of Dicumarol (R).
