Submit a storage stability study within 15 months from the date of this letter.



**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To operate, hold can upright, direct orifice toward the surface to be treated and press the actuator button. Do not use as a space spray. Do not spray near heat or open flame.

To kill crawling insects such as Ants, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Fire Brats, Pillbugs, Silverfish and Spiders, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, under carpets, along baseboards and door sills and frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.

To kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas, apply thoroughly as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters and nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Treat pets simultaneously with a product registered for use on pets to control the source of fleas and/or tick infestation.

To control flying insects such as, but not limited to Flies, Gnats, Hornets, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Wasps, Bees and Yellow Jackets, use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Directly spray insects whenever possible. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames and other sources of heat or ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.



If On Skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas thoroughly with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing before reuse. If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Bendiocarb is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate 2 mg. should be given by injection and repeated as necessary until fully atropinized.
