DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS & PREPARATIONS FOR USE: Read entire label carefully before using product.

Put out all flames and pilot lights. Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 170 cubic meters (6,000 cubic feet) of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. For automatic discharge, lock valve in open position by pressing valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table (in center of room) with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. To air out, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying room. Remove fallen insects. Repeat treatment in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Do not use this product on pets. Prior to reentry, treat dogs and cats with a product registered for use on pets.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames and any other sources of heat or ignition. **Disposal:** Replace cap, wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard

in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.
