DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before each use. For best results, container should be at about 70 F (21 C). Hold can upright, with spray button pointed away from face and other people. Spray upwards, directing spray toward center and corners of closed room. A 6 to 10 second spray is usually sufficient for a room of 1,000 cubic feet.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames and other sources of heat or ignition.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
