Your Application Dated January 9, 1989

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Please note that PR Notice 87-8 has been rescinded; thus, you are not required to use the wording required under that Notice. We have no objection to your proposed language.
  - b. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment add:
    - If Swallowed: Do Not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.
  - c. Revise the Precautionary Statement to:

If Swallowed: Do Not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

c. Revise the Precautionary Statement to:

Caution: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed . . . .

d. Under General Instructions for Use, add to the first sentence:

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### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:** Read the **WHOLE LABEL** carefully **BEFORE** using product. Do not use in food processing, preparation, storage, nor serving areas of food handling establishments. In homes, foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food preparation surfaces should be covered during treatment, or cleaned before using. Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to possibility of shock.

Always hold dispenser upright. Point spray opening away from face of other persons, or pets. Keep container at least 3 ft (1 m) from surfaces while spraying, those with low solvent resistance may be damaged if sprayed until wet. Push button firmly to spray. Spray directly on as many insects as possible. After treatment is completed, ventilate the area thoroughly.

**TO KILL FLIES, GNATS AND MOSQUITOES:** Close doors and windows, if possible. Turn off room ventilation. Thoroughly spray all parts of the room. Direct spray toward the ceiling and fill the area with a fine mist. Spray approximately 6 seconds in each 1,000 cu ft (28 cu m). Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated area. After treatment is completed, ventilate the area thoroughly before returning. Remove fallen insects.

**TO KILL ROACHES AND SILVERFISH:** Spray a light mist into all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests, especially cracks and hidden surfaces around sinks or food storage areas where they may be hiding. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL SPIDERS:** Direct a light spray mist around windows, doors, baseboards, and crawl spaces where these pests may occur. Spray directly on as many spiders as possible.

**TO KILL BEDBUGS:** Do not spray general sleeping surfaces, but direct a light spray mist under tufts, on edges of mattresses, and on frames and springs, as well as baseboards, and cracks in the floor and walls around the bedroom. Allow bedding to dry for at least 4 hours before using. Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.

**TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS:** Remove clothes from closets, brush them out, and air them out well. Spray all walls and shelves with a light mist. Spray clothes thoroughly with mist to kill moth larvae. Repeat spraying of clothes from drawers and closets every 30 days. Thoroughly dry clothes before use.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably closed) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames, and other sources of heat or ignition.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not regenerate or puncture.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

**IF IN EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing. Immediately wash skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing before reuse.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Contains the cholinesterase inhibitor DDVP. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition occur, Atropine Sulfate may be antidotal. This product also contains 1, 1, 1-Trichloroethane and Dichloromethane, which at extremely high inhalation levels may cause cardiac sensitization, avoid use of adrenalin type drugs, such as epinephrine, if this condition is suspected. Also consider health hazards of petroleum distillates and Methoxychlor before administering any treatment.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
