6. Add the statement "Do not use as a space spray" to the recommendatory text and/or directions for use

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Carpet Beetles: Spray infested cracks and hiding places thoroughly. Direct spray into moist places, and around sinks, bath tubs, drains, laundry tubs, pipes through walls and floors. Spray behind cabinets, stove, refrigerator and counters. Will not stain woodwork. To control carpet beetles spray the underside of carpets.

Ants: Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door frames and window sills. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces and partitions.
