This amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable, provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Under Statement of Practical Treatment If inhaled: the statement should read "Get medical attention if necessary.".
  - b. Under Statement of Practical Treatment If On Skin: change "Get medical attention." to "Get medical attention if irritation persists.".

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- c. Under Directions for Use add "Care should be taken to avoid spotting of walls, wall coverings, and fabrics. Do not spray directly to upholstery or furniture. Do not apply to areas, surfaces, or utensils which will contact food or feed. Exposed food should be covered or remove during application. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during application or thoroughly washed with soap and water before use. Do not use this product in conduits, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes."
- 3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Your current Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) does not list the impurities of toxicological concern separately nor does it include the diazinon certification for FIFRA Sec. 12(a)(1)(C), that the description of this product refers to the composition set forth on the CSF and supporting materials as required by the Diazinon Registration Standard. Please check with your supplier in this regard and update your CSF accordingly.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

How to Use: Remove the cap. Hold can upright. Press button to release spray. Spray surfaces to be treated only until wet. Spray infested surfaces until slightly moist, moving the spray stream rapidly to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Point spray away from people, plants, and pets. Do not introduce the spray into the air. Do not spray food or food-contacting surfaces. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Carpet Beetles: Spray infested cracks and hiding places thoroughly. Direct spray into moist places, and around sinks, bath tubs, drains, laundry tubs, pipes inrough walls and floors. Spray behind cabinets, stove, refrigerator and counters. Will not stain woodwork. To control carpet beetles spray the underside of carpets.

Ants: Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door frames and window sills. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants may come out into rooms from wall spaces and partitions.

Spiders and Scorpions: Spray wherever these pests may enter the home such as around door frames and window sills. In garages, storage sheds, cabins, outhouses, spray until wet where these pests crawl.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, flames and other sources of heat or ignition. Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. If clothing becomes wet from spray during use, remove clothing after spraying, wash affected body areas thoroughly with soap and water, and launder clothing before wearing again. ### Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting unless no other treatment is available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give person one or two glasses of water and touch finger to back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing. If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention. If On Skin: Wash promptly with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. Product contains xylene range aromatic solvent, which may present an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if product was taken internally.

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## Physical or Chemical Hazards
