DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before each use. For best results, container should be at about 70°F (21°C). Hold can upright, with spray button pointed away from face and other people. Spray upwards, directing spray toward center and corners of closed room. A 6 to 10 second spray is usually sufficient for a room of 1,000 cu. ft.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to humans and domestic animals: do not spray on or near exposed food. Cover food handling surfaces and utensils before spraying, or wash thoroughly after using spray. Do not spray toward eyes or face. Avoid excessive breathing of spray mist. In case of eye irritation from excessive contact, immediately flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, induce vomiting.

Physical or chemical hazards: Contents under pressure. Do not spray, use, or store near heat, open flame, sparks, red hot surfaces, or other sources of ignition and high temperatures. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F (54°C) may cause bursting.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Never puncture container nor throw into fire or incinerator.


