1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Revise Herpes Simplex Virus Types I and II to read "Herpes simplex Type 1 and Type 2" (two locations)
- b. Revise the statement "Spray 3-4 seconds (8-10) seconds for Herpes Simplex Virus Types I and II until surface is wet" to read
Spray until surface is thoroughly wet.
- c. Revise Influenza A2 Hong Kong (Asian) to read "Influenza A2/Japan (two locations)
- d. Delete the claim "Tuberculocidal"

Note: No data was submitted to support the claim

- e. Revise the statement (three locations)

"on inanimate Environmental Surfaces" to read

~~"on hard inanimate, nonporous, environmental surfaces"~~

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

(Clean surface thoroughly with an effective cleaning compound prior to treatment to remove all gross filth or heavy soil from all surfaces to be treated.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. Point valve opening toward area to be cleaned, press down firmly and spray evenly. Wipe clean with dry cloth, turning frequently.

TO DISINFECT: After surface is cleaned, hold can upright 6 to 8" from surface to be treated. Spray 3-4 seconds (8-10 seconds for Herpes Simplex Virus Types I and II) until surface is wet. Allow to dry without wiping or allow spray to contact treated surface for a minimum of ten minutes prior to wiping.

TO DEODORIZE: Hold can upright and direct spray toward center of room. Spray the air for 3-5 seconds.

(**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames and other sources of heat or ignition. **Disposal:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.
