The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The wording, "The use of this may product may be hazardous to health....potent cholinesterase inhibitor" is not required at this time and should be deleted from your labeling.
2. Delete "Do not allow children or pets to enter treated rooms....sprays have dried" and "Do not use in food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas of food handling establishments or homes." These statements incorrectly imply that your product is approved for indoor use.

This product is subject to the Agency's letter of April 17, 1995 regarding the deletion of certain DDVP use patterns. If you have not done so already, you must inform the Agency how you intend to respond to this letter.

Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE: Read the **WHOLE** label carefully, **BEFORE** using product. **FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY.** Do not use inside buildings inhabited by humans, domestic animals or pets.

Always hold dispenser upright. Point spray opening away from face, other persons or pets. Aim with caution, with spray opening toward nest, and pump button firmly to activate jet stream. Thoroughly wet the nest and any visible insects. Best personal safety and insecticidal results are obtained if the spraying is done during the evening after insects have congregated and are at rest.

The sprayed nests should be rid of these pests within 24 hours after treatment. The spray will leave a residual coating of insecticide that will continue to kill after application. If reinfestation occurs due to migration, removal of insecticide coating by rain or cleaning solution, or if insects return or rebuild nests, repeat the treatment.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames or other sources of heat or ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.

Wear chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt, long-legged pants, shoes and socks when handling the product. Do not allow children or pets to enter treated rooms until thoroughly ventilated, or to contact treated surfaces until sprays have dried.

Do not use on humans, domestic animals or pets. Do not use in food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas of food handling establishments or homes. Do not contaminate food, edible crops, feeds or drinking water. Do not contaminate those surfaces of any harvesting or processing equipment which will contact edible products. Do not use on nests located in fruit trees.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting due to aspiration hazard. Contact a physician or poison control center immediately. If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if necessary. If On Skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area of skin with soap and warm water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to reuse. If In Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Malathion and dichlorvos are organophosphate insecticides. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine. Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
