EPA Registration No. 706-76

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. Use type size complying with 40 CFR 156.10, formally 40 CFR 162.10.
2. ~~Provide the toxicology data or rationale why you add~~ the statement "causes moderate eye irritation." to the precautionary statements section.
3. Replace the statement "Contact a physician if irritation persists." with the statement "Get medical attention if irritation persists."
4. Remove the phrase "and other hiding places."
5. Replace the statement "In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application." with "In commercial food handling facilities, remove or cover food in such a way as to prevent pesticide contamination. Food contact surfaces and equipment must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by potable water rinse after treatment."
6. Replace the statement "In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, thoroughly washed before use." with "In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment in such a way as to prevent contamination or thoroughly washed before use."



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE: Read the **WHOLE** label carefully **BEFORE** using product.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, SAND FLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close doors and windows. With a slow sweeping motion, spray toward center of room for 5 - 10 seconds for the average room (1000 cu.ft.). Keep nozzle at least 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, ANTS, SOMBUGS, SPIDERS AND FLEAS: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting insects directly when possible. Spray ant hills and ant trails around windows, doorsills and other locations. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping areas. Repeat as necessary.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames or other sources of heat or ignition. **Disposal:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
