The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment listed below. As stated in the Agency letter dated February 21, 1989, provide the toxicology data or rationale why the statement "Causes mild eye irritation" was added to the Precautionary Statements section of the product label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE: Read the **WHOLE** label carefully, **BEFORE** using product. Do not use in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, SAND FLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close doors and windows. With a slow sweeping motion, spray toward center of room for 5-10 seconds for the average room (1000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle at least 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, CRICKETS, ANTS, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS AND FLEAS: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes, hitting insects directly when possible. Spray ant hills and ant trails around windows, doorsills and other locations. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping areas. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames and other sources of heat or ignition.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
