average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames or other sources of heat or ignition.
