1. Add the following statements to the precautionary labeling:

This product is toxic to fish. Remove pets and cover or remove fish aquariums before spraying.

2. Since the dielectric breakdown voltage has not been provided the following statement must be added to the directions for use:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

- 3. Revise the chemical name for tetramethrin as follows:
 - a. Delete the open bracket at the beginning of the name.
 - b. Change "dicarboximida" to "dicarboximido."

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows, and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

To Kill Cockrathes, Ants and Crickets: Spray as many insects as possible in addition to the cough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sachs, behind stoves and refrigerators, and storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, and trails, and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Sam-toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and discard infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be maid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, and behind stove and refrigorators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pests, around biseboards window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control priduct registered for use on pets before allowing them to enter treated area.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames or other sources of heat or ignition. Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.
