DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

User should always use this product with the wind at the user's back. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothing, do not stand directly under nest.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Point valve away from face and press button. Hold can at least 3 feet away from surfaces which may stain and 18 inches from plants.

FOR CONTROL OF NUISANCE PESTS

Direct spray at these insects using short bursts. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night. Best personal safety and insecticidal results are obtained if the spraying is done during the evening, after insects have congregated, and are at rest.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, windows, flames and other sources of heat or ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
