PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HARMFUL TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not apply direct to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not spray while food processing is underway. After spray spraying meat packing plants, laboratories and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled, thoroughly with an effective cleaning compound and rinse with potable water. GENERAL USE

For use in and around hotels, motels, homes, guesthouses and lodges, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, food houses, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, milk handling areas of milk, cheese and ice cream plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bathing plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, laboratories, ship cabins, and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate area for two hours before reentering patients. Also for use in houses, auto-washes, trucks, barns and ship cargo holds. Also for use in dog houses.

Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Also spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

HOUSES

FOR HOUSE FLIES, MOSQUITOES, Gnats, FLYING MOTTLEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES AND VESPAID FLIES: Close all doors and windows. Push remote sprayer direct to spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

FOR TICKLING INSECTS: COCHRANIDS (tick-bugs), BARNES, GROOM BITES, SCORPIONS (PILLOWS), SILVERFISH (PILLOWS), SPIDERS, CENTIPEDS, MILLIPEDS, FLIES, ANTS, COCKROACHES AND CRICKETS: Spray thoroughly and frequently into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, joint areas, openings around pipes and drains, under refrigerator, underneath, under leaves, bookshelves and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL MOSQUITOES AND LARVAE: Apply as a light treatment around lawns, flowerbeds, lawns, and other areas with grass or turf. Spray on lawns, lawns, and other areas. Repeat as necessary. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLIES AND TICKS ON DOGS, CATS AND PETS: Spray around dog house, under bedding, and on other areas on feet hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. TO KILL FLYING INSECTS: Spray areas infested with wasps, house flies, stable flies, dog flies and flying moths (milkweed moth). Hold container 10 to 24 inches (25-61 cm) in spray areas.
