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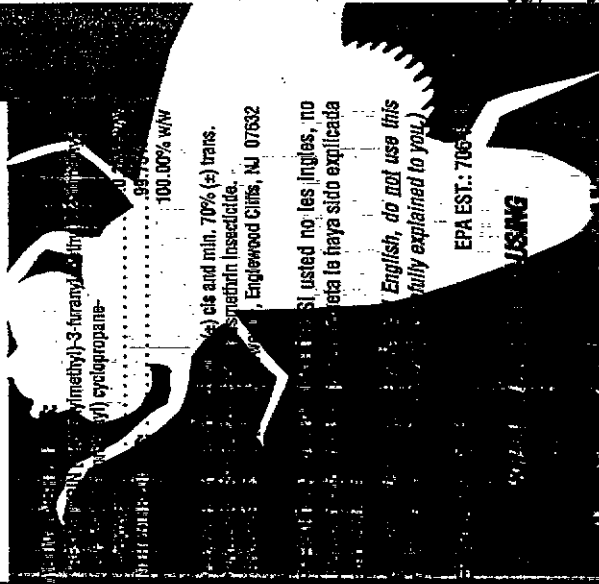

FLY JINX

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove all food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After spray spraying meat packing plants, ballrooms and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled, thoroughly with an effective cleaning compound and rinse with potable water. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use.
Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS
If in Eyes or on Skin: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS
This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply to treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.
PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS
Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 150°F (65°C) may cause bursting. Do not apply this water based product in crowded, indoor housing, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazards. Do not use on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.
STORAGE: Keep in a locked storage area.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Recycle can and discard container in a safe manner.
For use in and around hotels, motels, homes, greenhouses and lathouses, food handling establishments, parking and processing plants, seed houses, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, milk handling areas of milk, cheese and ice cream plants, milk storage rooms, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, boats, ship cabins, and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatments. Ventilate area for two hours before returning patients. Also for use in buses, automobiles, trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Also for use in dog kennels. Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.
INDOORS:
FOR HOUSE FLEAS, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS (MILLERS), FRUIT FLIES AND VINEGAR FLEES: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.
FOR DRAWING INSECTS: COCKROACHES (Waterbugs), EARWIGS, GRAY MITES, SPIDERS (PILGRIMS), SILVERFISH (FIREBRATS), SPIDERS,

CRICKETES, HILLPEDES, FLEAS, ANTS, BOODLICE AND CENTIPEDS: Spray thoroughly and frequently into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards, door frames, bookcases, and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.
TO KILL ANTS - INCLUDING FIRE ANTS: Spray doors, around window frames, and other points of entry. Spray ant trails, nests, and milk conducting as many ants directly as possible.
TO KILL BEDBUGS AND LICE: Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices around baseboards, floorboards, bedboards and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattress and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may harbor pests, concentrating on tufts, folds, and seams. Repeat as necessary. For persistent infestations, consult professional applicator.
TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS, CATS AND PHEMISES: Apply directly to animals along back, under bellies, and on other areas except scrotum and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about 1 foot (30cm) away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat within 24 hours of first treatment. If necessary, to reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray animal's bedding and other resting areas until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of 2 seconds per linear foot (30cm) at a distance of 12 to 18 inches (30 to 46 cm). Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary, thoroughly spraying bows, cracks, crevices and bedding. Hit as many insects directly as possible.
TO PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS: Spray infested African violets, plumbodendron, begonias, geraniums and cacti for control of aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, spider mites, and fungus gnats. Use with caution. To ascertain possible phytotoxicity, spray only a few plants, wait 24 hours, and check for possible injury.

OUTDOORS
TO KILL FLYING INSECTS: Spray areas infested with mosquitoes, gnats (midges), house flies, stable flies, deer flies and biting moths (millers). Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches (45-61 cm) from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard (0.76 cu. m) from these flying insects. Treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before reentering. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before reentering.
TO CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS: CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, EARWIGS, SPIDERS, MITES, SPIDERS AND HILLPEDES: Same as directed above for indoor use.
ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.
FIRE ANTS: Kills and temporarily reduces annoyance of these insects. To reduce annoyance from these ants and keep them from entering homes, spray patios, barbecue areas, driveways, door sills, window sills, other entrance areas, foundations of buildings, and trails, around pools and areas where the ants are infested. Spray until the area is wet containing as many insects as possible. This treatment will not kill the colonies, but will reduce the immediate population for up to four hours. Repeat as necessary. Avoid contacting plants, shrubbery and large areas of lawns.
FLEAS AND TICKS: Same as directed for indoor use.
SPIDERS: (Including Black Widow and Brown Recluse): Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

FOR HOUSE FLEAS, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS (MILLERS), FRUIT FLIES AND VINEGAR FLEES: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.
