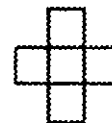
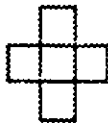

FOR USE ON INANIMATE

Including garments, bedding, furniture, floor and carpeting. Hold container upright with nozzle away from surface to be treated a distance of 10 inches. In inconspicuous area to test for penetration or discoloration, inspect after 10 minutes. If no penetration proceed to spray the entire area. Treat each square foot for 3 seconds. The spray to moisten all infested surfaces.

In treating bedding, make sure spray is directed into all corners of fitted sheets, blankets as well as the inside of pillow cases. In treating garments, headgear, (including sports equipment) be passed from player to player. Attention should be given to cuffs, collars, and creases. All bedding and all garments must be laundered in hot water or dry cleaned.

For mattresses, furniture and other crevices of infested areas, direct spray to moisten all folds and crevices of infested areas. Treat surface to dry completely.
