FOR USE ON INANIMATE SURFACES

Including garments, bedding, furniture, floor and carpeting. Hold spray nozzle upright with nozzle away from button and spray surface to be treated a distance of 10 inches. First, inspect inconspicuous area to test for possible discoloration, inspect after 30 seconds. If no discoloration, proceed to spray the entire area to be treated. Treat each square foot for 3 seconds. Allow the spray to moisten all infested surfaces.
