On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No.706-102."
- b. The statements under the section entitled "Physical and Chemical Hazards" must read as follows:

"Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting."

- b. Amend the Environmental Hazards section to include the following statement: "This product is toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment. Do not apply this product while bees are actively visiting the treatment area."
- c. CFR 156.10(A)(a)(5) states the following: "False or misleading statements. Pursuant to section 2(q)(1)(A) of the Act, a pesticide or a device declared subject to the Act pursuant to § 153.240, is misbranded if its labeling is false or misleading in any particular including both pesticidal and non-pesticidal claims."..... "Examples of statements or representations in the labeling which constitute misbranding include: "Non-numerical and/or comparative statements on the safety of the product, including but not limited to: (A) 'Contains all natural ingredients....' " The product descriptor "CONTAINS NATURAL PYRETHRUM" must either be removed or be modified to state "CONTAINS PYRETHRUM."
- d. A " STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT" is required on the label for the toxicology III category. Any of the following headings are acceptable: Statement of Practical Treatment, Practical Treatment, or First Aid.

Statements within this section must read as follows:

"IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists."

"IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention"

"IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention."

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.**

This insecticide may be used outdoors in gardens or in greenhouses throughout the growing season or as a pre-harvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

For best result, use throughout the growing season to prevent buildups of insects infestations. Spray plants from a distance of 1 1/2 to 2 feet using short bursts of 1 second. To prevent injury to plants, avoid visibly wetting the foliage.

Apply in the early morning or late evening when air is still, treating all foliage with particular attention to the underside of leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days or as reinfestation occurs.

**USE ON ORNAMENTALS:** African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, dogwood, geraniums, gladioli, marigolds, roses, rubber plants, and wandering Jew.

**TO CONTROL:** *Aphids, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, Whiteflies, Gypsy Moth Caterpillars and Adults, Tent Caterpillars, and Adult Japanese Beetles.*

**USE ON:** asparagus, beans, broccoli, cabbage, brussels sprouts, cauliflower, celery, cranberries, cucumbers, melons, squash, eggplants, lettuce, mustard greens, kale, collards, turnips, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, sweet corn and tomatoes.

**TO CONTROL:** *Asparagus Beetles, Aphids, Leafhoppers, Whiteflies, Mexican Bean Beetles, 12-spotted Cucumber Beetle, Cabbage Loopers, Cross-stripped Cabbage Worms, Diamondback Moth Caterpillars, Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Imported Cabbage Worms, Stink Bugs, Green Peach Aphids, Leafhoppers, Fireworms, Leafhoppers, Blister Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Webworms, Japanese Beetles.*
