Spray only those garments, parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry-cleaned. Allow sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

TO KILL TICKS and FLEAS: Spray around beds, furniture and pet's habitat. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bedding, floor and floor covering where pets are kept. Repeat as necessary. Use only a recommended pet spray on pets.
