

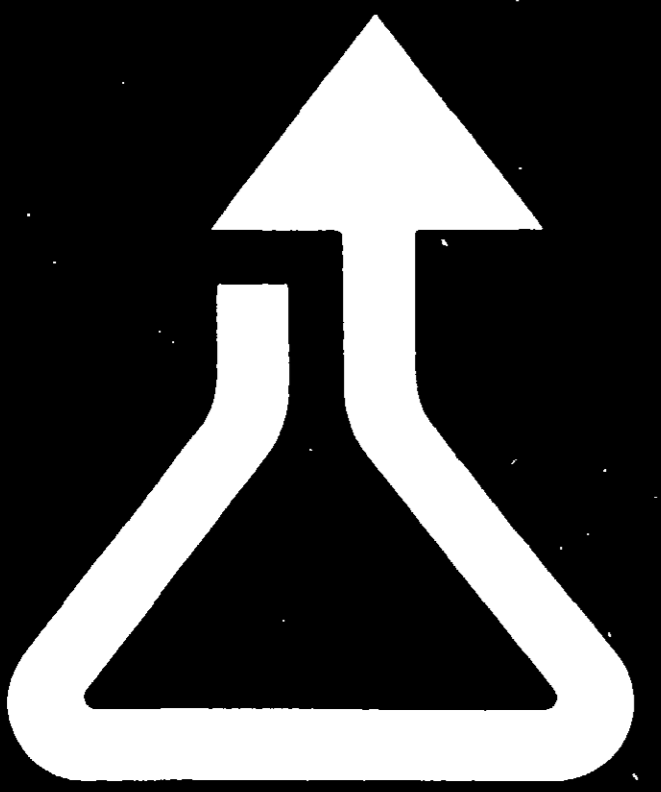

Thus, when withdrawing only a portion of the contents of this container, the Perthane should first be melted and stirred to insure use of homogeneous material. Perthane melts at approximately 105°F. and solubilizes most readily in molten form. Perthane in technical form should not be subjected to temperatures in excess of 125°F. Practical procedure for liquefying technical Perthane, therefore, is storage in circulating air at temperatures of 110° to 125°F.
