This product is intended for formulation into end-use herbicide products for uses listed on the KERB 50-W herbicide label.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
