STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Do not allow to become wet or overheated in storage. decomposition, impaired activity, or fire may result. Keep container closed when not in use. Pallets of containers should not be stacked more than three high. Provide access aisles for each two rows. Decomposition produces a foul odor; if observed, check for hot containers and immediately remove to open areas for disposal.
