It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FABRIC MILDEWCIDE
To prevent mildew in laundered or treated fabric, use 1.14 - 2.28 fluid ounces of Kathon LM Mildewcide for every 100 gallons of final rinse. Alternatively, use 0.68-1.37 fluid ounces of Kathon LM Mildewcide in the final rinse for every 100 pounds of fabric treated. Fabric may be re-treated as necessary to effect continued mildew protection. Fabric should be re-treated after every laundering.

LEATHER PRESERVATIVE
Kathon LM Mildewcide is recommended for the prevention of mold, bacteria, and fungi in the storage and transport of wet leather stock such as pickled, chrome-tanned, and vegetable-tanned leather.

Use Kathon LM Mildewcide at the levels specified in the following table to prevent microbial growth on processed hides. The level used will depend on storage conditions and the length of protection required. Pre-dilute Kathon LM 5-20 times with water and add the diluted product to the chrome liquor at the start of the tanning process.
