On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on her/his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. 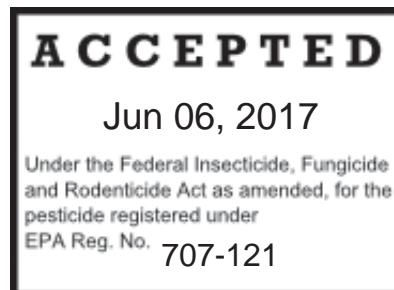

FABRIC MILDEWCIDE

To prevent mildew in laundered or treated fabric, use 1.14 - 2.28 fluid ounces of this product for every 100 gallons of final rinse. Alternatively, use 0.68-1.37 fluid ounces of this product in the final rinse for every 100 pounds of fabric treated. Fabric may be re-treated as necessary to effect continued mildew protection. Fabric should be re-treated after every laundering.

IN-CONTAINER PRESERVATION

Not registered for this use in the State of California – [Optional]

This product is recommended as an in-container preservative for the control of mold and fungi in industrial and household consumer products, including fabric softeners, laundry detergents, cleaners, dish detergents, polishes, pre-spotters and surfactants. Add 0.2 - 1.5 pounds of this product (91 - 680 gram) to each 1000 pound (453.6 kilogram) of product to be treated to provide 10 - 75 ppm active isothiazolone.

LEATHER PRESERVATIVE

Not registered for this use in the State of California – [Optional]

This product is recommended for the prevention of mold, bacteria, and fungi in the storage and transport of wet leather stock such as pickled, chrome-tanned, and vegetable-tanned leather.

Use this product at the levels specified in the following table to prevent microbial growth on processed hides. The level used will depend on storage conditions and the length of protection required. Pre-dilute this product 5-20 times with water and add the diluted product to the chrome liquor at the start of the tanning process.
